



## CZECH SQUASH JUNIOR OPEN 2010 EUROPEAN GRAND PRIX EVENT 22 - 24 JANUARY 2010

### TOURNAMENT

**DIRECTOR:** Tomas Forter (tel.: +420 776 814 960)

**CATEGORIES:** Boys under 19, under 17, under 15 and under 13  
Girls under 19, under 17, under 15 and under 13

Players may only enter one category. All places will be played out. Entries must be received by Monday, December 21, 2009.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Czech Junior Open is open to all players under the ages of 13, 15, 17 or 19 on 24 January 2010, as appropriate.

**SEEDING:** The seeding will be undertaken by the ESF using the European junior ranking valid at the closing date. The tournament director will seed any players from outside Europe who do not have an ESF Junior Ranking.

**MATCHES:** All matches will be played as best of five games (PAR 11 scoring), under the rules of the WSF. Players are guaranteed 3 matches.

**REFEREEING:** All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.



**BALL:** The DUNLOP PRO XX ball will be used.

**PRIZES:** There will be attractive prize money in the under 19 Boys and Girls categories (minimum total EUR 1800 - places 1-2-3). In case of smaller entries (less than 16 boys and/or 12 girls) the total prize money will be reduced to EUR 1200. Trophies and gift prizes will be awarded in all categories.

**INSURANCE:** Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organizers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participation in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance.

**EYE PROTECTION:** The wearing of approved eye protection is mandatory. A player will not be allowed to participate without approved eye protection.

All entries must be made through / endorsed by the player's National Federation. Entries which are not endorsed by the player's National Federation will not be accepted.

All entries will be acknowledged and full details of the centre, hotel and travel information will be sent to entrants or their association.

**ESF PENALTIES & REGULATIONS:** The tournament is part of the ESF Junior Circuit and will be run in accordance with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website [www.europeansquash.com](http://www.europeansquash.com). All participating MNAs should ensure that all relevant people (including managers, coaches and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

The penalties set out in the ESF Junior Guidelines at E.4.a), b) and c) will apply.

E.4.a) If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament (2 days or less before the start date), they must supply a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF office within two days after the final day of the tournament (email: [esf@europeansquash.com](mailto:esf@europeansquash.com); fax +44 1424 774879). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, they will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

E.4.b) If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, they will receive zero points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament (email: [esf@europeansquash.com](mailto:esf@europeansquash.com); fax +44 1424 202463). The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; and must cover the date of the relevant tournament.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, they will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

E.4.c) If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. Illness or injury must be verified by the tournament director and, if possible, by medical certificate sent to the ESF office within two days of the final day of the tournament. If zero points are awarded, the points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, they will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

**DRAWS:** The seeding and start times of first matches will be circulated to all players or their national association.

**TOURNAMENT WEBSITE:** The tournament website will be [www.csjo.cz](http://www.csjo.cz). There will be all the information about the tournament. During the tournament there will also be live internet streaming from the center court.

**ENTRY FEE:** **Package A - EUR 180,-** which includes the tournament fee, T-shirt, transport, 2 nights' hotel accommodation with breakfast, 3 lunches (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and two dinners (Friday and Saturday).

**Package B - EUR 75,-** which includes the tournament fee, T-shirt and food (three lunches (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and two dinners (Friday and Saturday).

**Package C - EUR 45,-** which includes the tournament fee and T-shirt.

Extra nights can be provided on request. Additional nights are available at EUR 40,- per night per player. There is also a limited number of single rooms. We can book them for you on your request for extra 25 EUR per night per person.

**CANCELLATIONS:** For withdrawals/cancellations between January 8 and 19, 2010, 50% of the package fee (less any bank charges) is refundable.  
Hotel packages can not be refunded for any cancellations received on or after 20 January, 2010.

**TRANSPORT:** (Package A) Transport will be provided from Prague - Ruzyne Airport and Prague Main station, if the tournament director is advised of the arrival time up to 48 hours in advance.  
A regular shuttle service will be provided between the hotel and the venue(s) during the tournament.
